



## FAMILY WINEMAKERS RANKS #10 AMONG THE WORLD'S BEST VINEYARDS

Durigutti Family Winemakers celebrates a year of international achievements, once again standing out in the prestigious World’s Best Vineyards 2024 rankings at #10, the only Argentine winery in this year’s global Top 10. The ceremony, held at Nyetimber Estate in Sussex, England, brought together the most distinguished names in the wine industry, where experts from around the world recognized the unique experience offered by the winery at its estate in Las Compuertas, Mendoza.

This recognition crowns a remarkable year for Durigutti Family Winemakers, which was also honored in the **Best of Mendoza’s Wine Tourism 2025 awards**, celebrated on September 6 in Mendoza, Argentina. Durigutti Family Winemakers received two accolades: **Bronze in Culinary Experiences for its 5 Suelos – Cocina de Finca restaurant and Silver in Sustainable Practices**, highlighting the winery’s commitment to responsible and impactful tourism.

These honors confirm that we’re on the right path to celebrate our land and roots, said Héctor Durigutti, winemaker and co-founder alongside his brother, Pablo. “Our vision is for the world to know Las Compuertas and its history, and for our unique location to be recognized as one of the best places to experience unforgettable wine and gastronomy at an international level.

Since its founding in 2002, Durigutti Family Winemakers has grown into a comprehensive winery, adding a restaurant, guest accommodations, event spaces, and a variety of wine tourism experiences to its offerings. With a deep commitment to sustainability and respect for its natural surroundings, Finca Victoria’s vineyards have been transformed into a biological corridor dedicated to regenerative and organic agriculture, emphasizing biodiversity and ecosystem preservation.

This major international milestone for a family-owned winery with a big spirit adds to a series of awards recently received for its wines and tourism approach. Highlights include Winemakers of the Year 2023 for Héctor and Pablo Durigutti by Tim Atkin and the Platinum Best in Show medal at the Decanter Wine Awards for their Durigutti Pie de Monte Malbec Finca Las Jarillas 2020. The 5 Suelos – Cocina de Finca restaurant has garnered both regional and international accolades, cementing its reputation as a culinary experience of quality, authenticity, and soul. Among its recent honors are the Best of Mendoza’s Wine Tourism awards, FED Tourism Awards, and its recommendation as one of the top spots in the 2024 Michelin Guide.

“This year is a rewarding testament to the hard work and dedication of our entire team. We are immensely proud that experts around the world recognize the value of what we’ve created at Finca Victoria, a project that began as a family dream and is now a significant international wine tourism destination,” said Pablo Durigutti.

In this year’s Top 50 World’s Best Vineyards ranking, Argentina is represented by six wineries, affirming the country’s status as a premier wine tourism destination, where excellence in service, the warmth of its people, and the beauty of its landscapes create unique experiences for international visitors.

### ABOUT DURIGUTTI FAMILY WINEMAKERS



Founded in 2002, **Durigutti Family Winemakers** was the shared dream of brothers and winemakers Héctor and Pablo Durigutti. Established in the heart of the Las Compuertas GI in Mendoza, the winery’s journey began in 2007 with the acquisition of Finca Victoria, located in a historically and culturally significant winemaking valley with pre-phylloxera vines dating back to the early 1900s. From the beginning, the brothers have had a clear vision: to restore the vitality of this productive corridor, bring out the best of the terroir, and place Las Compuertas firmly on the international map as an oasis for wine and tourism. Today, Finca Victoria houses a winery dedicated to offering an immersive connection with nature, traditions, and wine. Driven by a sustainable agroecology philosophy, it preserves both the cultural heritage and biodiversity of the area. Every line of their products, certified vegan and organically produced at Finca Victoria, is exported to over 20 countries and has received high praise and recognition worldwide.

**5 Suelos – Cocina de Finca** is the estate’s restaurant, inaugurated in April 2022 at Finca Victoria (Las Compuertas, Mendoza). Its farm-to-table approach complements the wine tourism experience in a beautifully tranquil setting that embraces the visitor. Named for the five soil profiles identified in the vineyard, the restaurant celebrates the value of artisanal, home-cooked cuisine, emphasizing seasonal, local ingredients sourced from the estate’s own garden and neighboring small producers. Under the direction of Executive Chef Patricia Courtois, an ambassador of Argentina’s Marca País, 5 Suelos is a living cuisine that celebrates wine as the centerpiece of every experience. The restaurant has won consecutive Silver and Bronze medals at the Best of Mendoza’s Wine Tourism awards since 2023 and was selected as a Recommended Restaurant in Mendoza in the inaugural 2024 edition of the Michelin Guide. It currently offers a variety of culinary experiences, including the 5 Suelos Menu with à la carte options, the History Menu with 14 wine pairings that narrates the history of Argentine wine and the winery’s journey over more than 20 years, and the Parrales Menu, an outdoor garden-to-table experience.
