Excellent scores of Tim Atkin for PROYECTO Las Compuertas Malbec 5 Suelos 95 points and Cordisco 92 points

The recent venture of the Durigutti brothers, presented at the end of 2017, is already beginning to reap its fruits. Happily the wine style of **PROYECTO Las Compuertas**, has brought the first positive international ratings. The Malbec 5 Soils 2016 and the Cordisco 2017 obtained 95 and 92 points respectively.

"In addition to enormous satisfaction, it is a great incentive to continue working on this project whose main focus is the revaluation of the history and traditions of an emblematic wine region of Luján de Cuyo, such as Las Compuertas", says Héctor Durigutti, in this new stage of the winery and new initiatives that he is developing together with his brother Pablo.

ABOUT THE WINES:

Proyecto Las Compuertas Malbec 5 Suelos 2016, based on the results obtained from the soil study in our Finca Victoria, five wines are obtained according to the different profiles. Each wine is made separately in cement eggs and then the final cut is made to achieve this estate wine with all its expression. It is bred in third and fourth use 500-liter oak barrels for 8 months. Suggested value: \$ 395.

Proyecto Las Compuertas Cordisco 2017, born from an experimental parcel of the family estate, giving rise to the first Mendoza wine of this unique varietal from Abruzzo (Italy). This wine was fermented in cement eggs with native yeasts. Suggested value: \$ 370.

"The four wines that today make up PROYECTO Las Compuertas are the beginning of a long path of exploration that we have been following. It is our way of living, feeling and interpreting the essence of Las Compuertas, a place we love and where we lived many years ago. Through minimal but fundamental interventions, we seek that each bottle expresses the best of this origin, Las Compuertas," says Pablo Durigutti.
