DURIGUTTI FAMILY WINEMAKERS CONSOLIDATES ITS POSITION AS THE BEST-RANKED ARGENTINE WINERY IN THE WORLD'S BEST VINEYARDS 2025

The winery achieved the No. 11 global position after the ceremony held in Margaret River, Western Australia

Durigutti Family Winemakers has once again been recognized among the world's leading wine tourism destinations following the official announcement of the **World's Best Vineyards 2025**, held on November 19 in Margaret River, Western Australia. This year, the winery reached the **No. 11 spot worldwide**, reaffirming its status as **the highest-ranked Argentine winery** and strengthening its leadership on the international stage.

The ceremony gathered key figures from the global wine, gastronomy, and tourism industries, who celebrated the 50 most outstanding projects for their excellence in hospitality, innovation, identity, and memorable visitor experiences. In this context, Durigutti Family Winemakers stood out once again thanks to the comprehensive proposal developed at its estate, **Finca Victoria**, located in the heart of the **Las Compuertas GI**, Mendoza.

A family project that continues to grow and set trends. This year's recognition reinforces the path forged by brothers and winemakers **Héctor and Pablo Durigutti**, who for over two decades have been working to honor the viticultural legacy of Las Compuertas and its productive, cultural, and landscape heritage. Throughout 2025, the winery continued expanding its wine tourism proposal with new experiences, biodiversity educational circuits, and improvements in infrastructure, maintaining a strong commitment to **certified organic agriculture, regenerative viticulture, innovation, and sustainability**.

"That our family project continues to be recognized among the best in the world is a great source of pride and a confirmation of the impact our place has on those who visit us," expressed Héctor and Pablo Durigutti following the announcement. *"Our goal has always been to position Las Compuertas as a destination of international relevance, and this award once again opens doors for more people to discover what we are building in this very special place."*

Hospitality, biodiversity, and gastronomy with identity. The winery's comprehensive offering combines centenary pre-phylloxera vineyards and historic plots of the Las Compuertas GI with a developing biological corridor and a unique terroir that protects native flora and fauna through regenerative practices. Visitors can enjoy two restaurants— the award-winning **5 Suelos – Cocina de Finca** and the newly launched **Las Compuertas Bodegón**, both led by chef Patricia Courtois—ample spaces for events of all kinds, guided wine circuits, and estate lodging in its guest houses. All of this is grounded in a work philosophy based on respect for the land, responsible use of resources, and organic and sustainable winemaking. These pillars have shaped a destination that celebrates authenticity, local cuisine, territorial memory, and a deep connection with wine in its place of origin.

A new boost for Argentine wine tourism. With this achievement, Durigutti Family Winemakers once again leads Argentina's presence within the Top 50, in an edition that brought together wineries from five continents. The winery's consistent presence among the highest-ranked positions not only strengthens its positioning but also contributes to elevating Mendoza and Argentina as world-class wine tourism destinations.

About Durigutti Family Winemakers. Durigutti Family Winemakers was founded in 2002 as the family project of brothers Héctor and Pablo Durigutti. In 2007, they established Finca Victoria in the Las Compuertas GI, where today an integrated ecosystem unfolds: vineyards, winery, gastronomy, lodging, events, and visits.
